Duration of Study

3. Notwithstanding the <u>General Academic Regulations - Postgraduate Taught Degree</u>

<u>Programme Level</u>, the minimum duration of study for the full time programme will be 24 months and the maximum duration will be 48 months and for the part time programme the minimum duration of study will be 36 months and the maximum duration will be 72 months.

Award

- 10. **Degree of MSc in Counselling and Psychotherapy:** In order to qualify for the award of the degree of MSc in Counselling and Psychotherapy a candidate must have performed to the satisfaction of the Board of Examiners and must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits of which 60 must have been awarded in respect of the dissertation.
- 11. Postgraduate Diploma: In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in

Counselling and Psychotherapy a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the taught modules from the programme curriculum.

12. **Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certificate in Counselling and Psychotherapy a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the taught modules from the programme curriculum.
