Mode of Study

1. The programme is available by full-time study only.

Place of Study.

- 2. The programme involves placements in schools for which a student must be a member of the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme. If they are already a member, they must apply for an update.
- 3. The students who spend all or part of an academic year at an overseas university as an accredited part of their undergraduate degree studies will be designated as BA Honours in Primary Education with International Study.

Assessment

Retrieval placement

10. For all placement modules, where a student is entitled to be offered a retrieval placement, this will be offered if there is opportunity for the student to achieve all credits. If a student has exhausted their attempts at passing other modules, and therefore there is no opportunity for them to achieve all credits required of the programme, the student will not be offered a retrieval placement.

In order to progress to the second year of the programme, in addition to satisfying the requirements of <u>General Academic Regulations Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level,</u> a student must pass X2106 Placement Learning: Children's wellbeing and development in the community
- 12. In order to progress to the third year of the programme, in addition to satisfying the requirements of <u>General Academic Regulations Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level</u>, a student must also pass X2234 Year 2 Pedagogy and Professional Practice: Children as learners and thinkers.
- 13. In order to progress to the fourth year of the programme, the <u>General Academic</u> <u>Regulations Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree</u> <u>Programme Level shall apply.</u>

Award

14. Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Primary Education: In order to qualify for the award of the BA with Honours in Primary Education, in addition to satisfying the requirements of <u>General Academic Regulations – Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level</u>, a student must pass X2435 Year 4 Pedagogy and Professional Practice: Professionalism in action; and X7453 Dissertation (Education).

- 15. **Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Primary Education with International Study**: In order to qualify for the award of the BA with Honours in Primary Education with International Study, in addition to satisfying the requirements of <u>General Academic Regulations Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level,</u> a student must pass X2435 Year 4 Pedagogy and Professional Practice: Professionalism in action; X7453 Dissertation (Education) and must include at least one semester at a partner institution abroad.
- 16. **Bachelor of Arts in Humanities and Social Sciences**: In order to qualify for the award of BA in Humanities and Social Sciences, see <u>General Academic Regulations</u> <u>Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme</u> Level.
- 17. Bachelor of Arts in Humanities and Social Sciences with International Study: In order to qualify for the award of the BA in Humanities and Social Sciences with International Study, see General Academic Regulations Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level, and a student must include a pass in at least one of the external placement modules.
- 18. **Diploma of Higher Education:** In order to qualify for the award of Diploma of Higher Education in Humanities and Social Sciences, see <u>General Academic Regulations Undergraduate</u>, <u>Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level</u>.
- Certificate of Higher Education: In order to qualify for the award of Certificate of Higher Education in Humanities and Social Sciences, see <u>General Academic</u> <u>Regulations – Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree</u> <u>Programme Level.</u>
