


## Connecting to eduroam on a Linux laptop


You will first need to configure your laptop in order to connect to eduroam. To do this you will need to download and install a configuration tool. This can be done by connecting to the StrathWifiSetup network available in the Library and Student Residences. The following instructions show the steps for doing so on a Linux laptop. Different versions of Linux may vary slightly in layout but the process will remain the same. You will only need to configure your device once and thereafter it will automatically connect to eduroam.




1. Click on the notification centre on the taskbar.

2. In the drop-down menu, click on Wi-Fi Not Connected.


3. In the drop-down menu, click on Wi-Fi Settings.




4. Click on StrathWifiSetup.



5. Open a browser and go to [cat.eduroam.org](http://cat.eduroam.org). Click on Click here to download your eduroam installer.



6. In the pop-up window, enter Strathclyde.



7. Click on University of Strathclyde.



8. Click on Download your eduroam installer Linux.



9. Once the download is complete, click on the Home button.


10. In the pop-up menu, click on Terminal.


11. In Terminal, type `cd Downloads`, then hit Enter.

```


12. Type `python3 eduroam-linux-UoS-Eduroam_2019.py`, then hit Enter.




13. In the eduroam configuration wizard, click on OK.



14. Click on Yes.




15. Click on Yes.




16. Enter your DS username before the `@strath.ac.uk`. For example, `bsb09111@strath.ac.uk`.


Click on OK.




17. Enter your password, then click on OK.



18. Enter your password, then click on OK.




19. Click on OK.




20. Close off Terminal.




21. Click on notifications centre on the taskbar.




22. In the drop-down menu, click on StrathWifiSetup.
